Hereinbefore inserted Joseph Square Bull shall divide the same share and share alike each taking one third the portion hereby given devised and bequeathed to each respectively and no more and I further hereby direct that in the case of the decease of one or more of the hereinbefore named legatees before my affairs as herein mentioned are or may be executed his or their share or shares shall be equally divided among amongst the survivor or survivors of them I do further declare that all other documents or Memorandums that may be produced tending to contradict this my Will in any way whatsoever whether directly or indirectly are false I do also hereby direct and appoint Ephraim Director of No 18 Dover Strand Street in the Parish of St Paul Amary Newington in the County of Surrey as sole true Executor hereof to whom I hereby give devise and bequeath the sum of £2. I do also further wish and direct that my son in law the above mentioned Joseph Square Bull have the conducting regulating and ordering my funeral in such manner as he may think fit and proper to direct and to whom I have given instructions relating thereto in Wills whereof the said Deceased Bull the Testator has to this my last Will and Testament contained in 2 sheets of paper of my hand this 16th day of January 1841.

PROVED at London 22^d November 1843 before the Worshipful John Davenport Doctor of Laws and Serjeant at Law of Epitaphium Director the sole Executor to whom a Power was granted having been first sworn duly to administer

Thomas Bartrop of No 96 Philip Street Kingsland Road in the County of Middlesex Gentleman do this eleventh day of January one thousand eight hundred and forty one make this my last Will and Testament in the first place I direct my just debts funeral and testamentary expenses to be fully paid and satisfied I do hereby nominate constitute and appoint my Grandson Robert Bartrop and living at No 63 Pittabilly London and my son Stephen William Dammours of St. Sepulchres Market Mansell Middlesex Esquire Executor of this my Will and give and bequeath unto the said William Dammours the sum of five pounds I direct that the whole of my property Estate and Effects not converted of account or stock shall be converted into money and the said shall be first paid my debts funeral and testamentary expenses and the balance above mentioned and after payment thereof and subject thereto as to two fifths parts of the whole residue of my Estate and Effects the whole into five equal parts being considered as divided I give and bequeath unto two fifth parts unto and equally between my said Grandson Robert Bartrop and my Granddaughter Ann Bartrop for their own

absolute use and benefit and as to the remaining three a
fifth parts the same to continue invested in the stocks or
funds in which it may be standing at my decease or be
invested / if otherwise / in the names of my said Executors
in some or one of the Government stocks or funds of Great
Britain and I direct that the interest and dividends arising
from the whole of such remaining three fifth parts of my said
Estate shall be received by my daughter Mary Harland the
Wife of James Harland of Cambridge Town Middlesex for and
during the term of her natural life / but subject to the
deduction of such interest from time to time by the particular
out of the principal of such three fifths of the several
legacies next hereinafter mentioned / and I give and
bequeath out of the principal of such three fifth parts
twenty pounds apiece to each of my Grandchildren Augustus
Edmund and Charlotte Harland and of one hundred pounds
to my Grandson Charles Harland the children of my said
daughter Mary Harland as and when they severally and
respectively attain the age of twenty one year and from and
immediately after the decease of my said daughter Mary
Harland as to the remainder of the principal of the said
three fifths not disposed of and also all the *residuum*
and remainder of my Estate and Effects whatsoever and
wheresoever and of what nature or kind soever not herein
before disposed of I give devise and bequeath the same
and every part thereof unto and equally amongst my said
four Grandchildren Augustus Edmund Charlotte and Charles
Harland share and share alike as and when they severally
and respectively attain the age of twenty one year and I
direct that the shares of such of them as shall be minors at
the time of the decease of my said daughter shall be invested
and bear interest in some of the Government stocks of Great
Britain for their benefit and I direct that if any one or more
of my said four Grandchildren the children of my said
daughter shall die before attaining the age of twenty one
years his or her share or shares shall go to and belong
to the survivor or survivors who shall attain that age and if but one
shall attain that age then the whole of such remaining
principal residue and remainder to such only one and I
direct that all parts shares or interests in my Estate and
Effects to which any female or females may become entitled
under this my Will shall be taken and received by her or
their own sole and separate use and benefit independent of
any husband to whom they may be married or may be
married and that the receipts of such females above
mentioned standing in virtue shall be good and sufficient and the
only proper discharges to my Executors for all such parts
shares or interests respectively and I do hereby declare that
my said Executors and the survivor of them and the
Executors and Administrators of such survivor shall and
may at all times out of the first monies that may come to
their hands reimburse themselves all such expenses as
as they may be put to or sustain in and about the
Execution of this my Will and that they shall not be
answerable for any accidental loss unless the same
happen through their own wilful default nor be answerable
the one for the other of them nor for more monies than

shall actually come into his or their hands respectively and hereby revoking and making void all former Wills by me made I declare this to be my only last Will and Testament in witness whereof I the said Thomas Bartrop the Testator have to this my last Will and Testament set my hand the day and year first above written - *Thos. Bartrop* - Signed by the Testator Thomas Bartrop in the presence of us present at the same time who have hereunto subscribed our names as in witnesses this eleventh day of January 1841 - *Thomas Drake* No 15 Amherst Terrace Shacklewell Middlesex - *Edwin Skene* No 3 Little Marfields London E.

Bartrop" and this was deponeed having now with care and attention viewed and compared the said Will and more particularly observed the before noted signature thereto further made Oath that he was present at the execution thereof by the said Testator to wit on the eleventh day of January one thousand eight hundred and forty one being the date of the said Will and that there was also present Edwin Skene his fellow subscribed witness thereto and that the said Testator did then set and subscribe his said name at the foot or bottom of the said Will in manner and form as the same now appears in the presence of this my deponent and the said Edwin Skene who in the presence of the Testator and of each other respectively signed their names in thereto in manner and form as the same now appear - *Thomas Drake* On Saturday the eighteenth day of 11th month of November 1843 the said Thomas Drake was duly sworn to the truth of the foregoing Affidavit before me - *J. Proved at London 22nd November 1843 before the Worshipful Judge Abraham Dorrer of Laws and Surrogate by the Oaths of Robert Bartrop the Grandson and William Dorrer Dorrer the Nephew the Executors to whom Administration was granted having been first sworn duly to administer
