



Code of Conduct for Junior Members

Macclesfield & District Canoe Club is fully committed to safeguarding and promoting the wellbeing of all its members. The club believes that it is important that members, coaches, administrators and parents associated with the club should, at all times, show respect, be encouraged to be open at all times and to share any concerns or complaints that they may have about any aspect of the club with any committee member.

Junior Members:

As a member of Macclesfield & District Canoe Club you are asked to abide by the following junior club rules at all times:

- Cooperate fully, respecting all requests and decisions made by the coaches, helpers, officials and administrators.
- Be on time for coaching sessions and events or inform your coach if you are going to be late.
- Paddlers must control their tempers and avoid behaviour which may inconvenience or upset others.
- Be considerate and respectful to other paddlers and water users – treat other paddlers as you would want to be treated.
- Paddlers must wear suitable kit for paddling as agreed with your coach.
- Take care of all property belonging to the club or any club member – and be responsible for caring for your own equipment and clothing.
- Not to leave sessions without the permission of the coach or leader.
- Junior members are not allowed to smoke, consume alcohol or drugs of any kind whilst being on club premises or representing the club at events.
