

## Charges For Use Of MADCC Equipment.

The charges below were agreed at the Club Committee meeting in March 2005.

- The Club Committee believes that annual subscriptions should be used to cover the regular club expenditure which benefits all members and that, where possible, club equipment should be largely self-funding through a “pay-for-use” approach. The Committee believes this is the arrangement which is fairest to all members.
- The Committee generally expects members to provide their own equipment, but recognises that this is not always appropriate.
- Charges are made for the use of club equipment in order to cover wear and tear and to help the club towards the repair and/or replacement costs.
- The charges do apply at club practice and training sessions, and for all private use.
- The charges do not apply at formal club events, such as interclub Racing events or at the club’s “Hare and Hounds” events.

As at March 2005, the charges are:

- No charge is made for use of club buoyancy aids, paddles, split paddles, or bivouac tent.
- Equipment must be returned in the condition it was in when borrowed. Any loss or damage should be made good, or be paid for.
- The VHF radio is for use only by those holding the relevant operator’s licence.
- Equipment users are requested to pay the relevant charge either direct to the Treasurer, or to use the “Honesty Box” in the boat store.
- Where appropriate, advance booking of equipment should be made through the Equipment Officer.
