A good selection of easier dances including 'Galopede' 'Circassian Circle' and 'Brown Jug Polka' (suspiciously like Pat-a-Cake Polka) in Volume 1 and 'Oxo Reel' among others in Volume 11. Dances called on tape/CD, at a slow steady pace.
