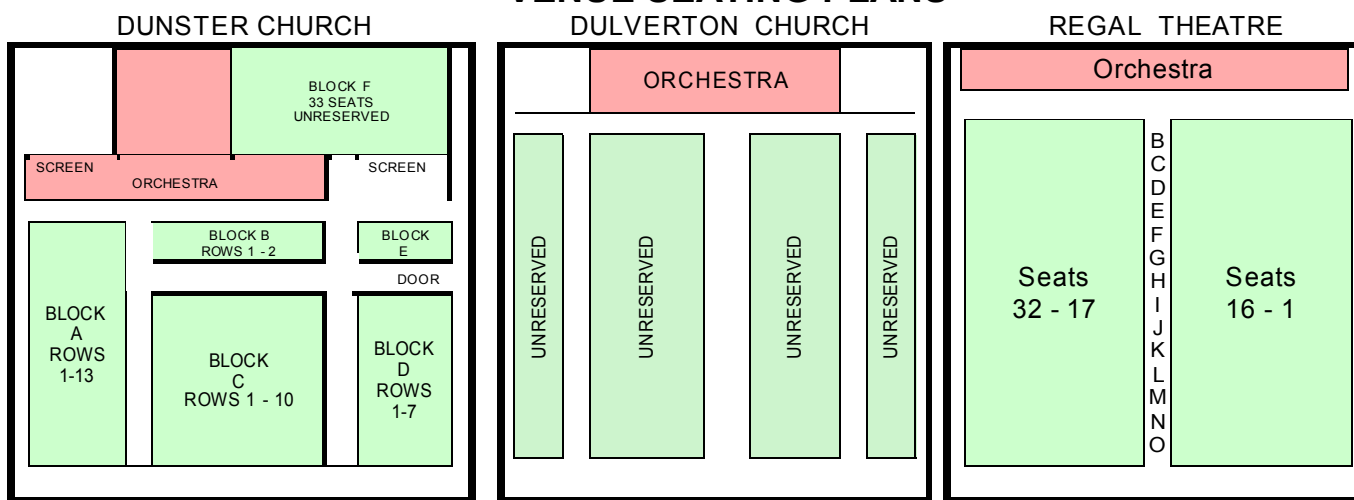
Friends will receive advance notice of next year's programme and priority booking for this season with a better chance of getting the seats they want.
