Diocese Initiative on Climate Change I have received the following from Robert Thornyaker would like to invite you and interested members of your congregation to a consultation service on the morning of Saturday 21st April 2012 in York Minster Bishop Terry of Middlesbrough and Dr Sena of the Archbishop of York, head of an Ecumenical service, which will mark the release of data from the Christian Census on Climate Change.
