

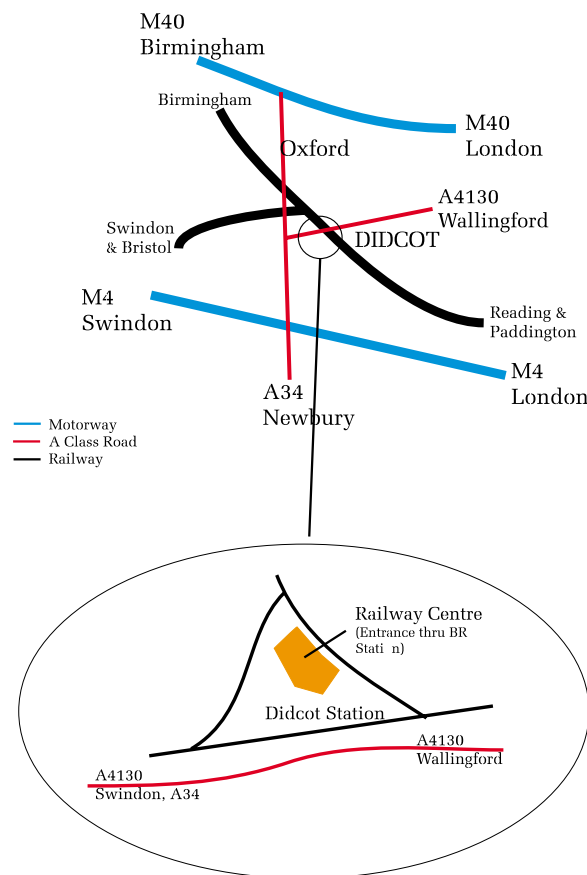
How to find 4079 “Pendennis Castle” at the Great Western Society’s Didcot Railway Centre

Didcot is 53 miles west of London, 10 miles south of Oxford. The Railway Centre is signposted from the M4 motorway (junction 13) and A34. It is easily reached from the M40, or you can choose a scenic drive through the Thames Valley or across the Berkshire Downs.

Parking is readily available near Didcot Parkway railway station (please note that the access from the signed car park to the railway station entrance is over a foot bridge. You may find it convenient for passengers to disembark at the station entrance before the driver parks the car). A parking fee might be required.

By train: Virgin, Thames Trains, Wales & West and First Great Western serve Didcot Parkway. Direct services from London Paddington, Reading and the Thames Valley, the South Coast, Oxford, the Midlands, Swindon, Bath, Bristol and South Wales. For National Rail Enquiries call 0845 748 4950.

By Bus: Stagecoach Oxford from Oxford, Abingdon and Wantage daily; Thames Travel from Wallingford (weekdays).
