PLAINCHANT MASS SETTINGS – As a response to the Holy Father's and the Bishops Conference prompting 'to say or sing together in Latin those parts of the Ordinary of the Mass belonging to them' the Liturgy Group has arranged for Judy Reid (the organist from St Elizabeth's) to lead us in a practice of the Kyrie, Sanctus and Agnus Dei from the plainchant Mass Jubilate Deo. With a view to adding this as one of the mass settings we use. The practice will be immediately after the 11am Mass on Sunday 13th December.
